DIRECTIONS

Lea Cottage is located in the centre of the village on the main road, past the duck pond

Directions – S32 5QR should find the cottage

Driving: From the centre of Sheffield: Follow A625 southwards to Calver (about 12 miles). Turn right at the lights onto A623 for half a mile through Stoney Middleton, past the turn-off for Eyam and Foolow will be the next turn-off on your right as you come out of the trees. Proceed straight ahead until the Bulls Head is in front of you. Turn left and as you pass the duck pond you will see Lea Cottage ahead of you on the right, a light-coloured stone cottage with the arch window entrance to Lea Cottage.

From Derby: Follow A6 north through Matlock and on to Bakewell. In Bakewell town centre turn right on A619 for ¾ of a mile and turn left on B6001. Continue for 3½ miles to Calver. Turn left at the lights onto A623 for half a mile through Stoney Middleton, past the turn-off for Eyam and Foolow will be the next turn-off on your right as you come out of the trees. Proceed straight ahead until the Bulls Head is in front of you. Turn left and as you pass the duck pond you will see Lea Cottage ahead of you on the right, a light-coloured stone cottage with the arch window entrance to Lea Cottage.

Travelling North on M1: Leave at Junction 29. Follow A617 to Chesterfield, then A619 (signposted Chapel-en-le-Frith) for 8½ miles to Baslow. Take the A623 to Calver. Continue straight on at the lights for half a mile through Stoney Middleton, past the turn off for Eyam and Foolow will be the next turn-off on your right as you come out of the trees proceed straight ahead until the Bulls Head is in front of you. Turn left and as you pass the duck pond you will see Lea Cottage ahead of you on the right, a light-coloured stone cottage with the arch window entrance to Lea Cottage.

From the centre of Manchester: Follow A6 southwards through Stockport, Hazel Grove, Disley for nearly 20 miles. Shortly beyond the Chapel-en-le-Frith by-pass (dual carriageway) turn left onto the A623. Follow A623 through Sparrowpit and Peak Forest for 9 miles. Carry on past Tideswell Crossroads for 3 miles until the turning for Foolow on your right, turn right again and proceed until you have The Bulls Head in front of you. Turn left and as you pass the duck pond you will see Lea Cottage ahead of you on the right, a light-coloured stone cottage with the arch window entrance to Lea Cottage.
